

“In the absence of clerical or mechanical mistakes, fraud, bad faith, or in competency on the part of the teacher, grades given by the teacher to each pupil shall be final and not subject to change by others. A board or superintendent shall not order a grade changed unless the teacher who gave the grade is given the opportunity to state orally, or in writing, or both, the reasons the grade was given, and is, to the extent practicable, included in all discussions relating to the changing of the grade.”
